Minutes of the fifth NDP meeting on 24th June 2014

Councillor Summers and Councillor Thornley reported back on the interest shown by residents at the Carnival. There was a slow start, but people did gather to study the maps and ask questions about the Neighbourhood Development Plan. 30 maps were completed (some by families or groups of friends looking at the map together)

The top three areas highlighted for development were Bull Ring Farm Road (13) Bush Heath Lane (9) and Pineham Farm Land (12).

45 Questionnaires were completed. There were 10 questions to respond to and people ticked boxes or wrote comments. The majority of concerns were over "capacity at the doctor's surgery" and "places at local schools". (Q.5) These questionnaires can be analysed in the future when more of them are completed by residents.

The lack of commitment by the Steering Committee and upcoming holidays meant that the six people at this meeting took a decision to cancel meetings in June and July and organise the next meeting on Tuesday 16th September.
