## 15/195 Harbury Estate Development

Andy Wilkins had sent his apologies but had emailed information relating to the proposed new doctors surgery at Bishop's Itchington and the additional housing on the former cement works site. These will form two separate planning applications and it is anticipated that they will be submitted to SDC in December.

## 15/196 Public Participation

## Planning Application at 1 Dovehouse Lane

This application has only been sent out for public consultation earlier this week. There are no site notices displayed yet and residents have not received neighbour notifications from SDC either. The parish council was asked to defer its consideration of this matter until a later date to give residents time to make their representations to the council. The chairman asked members of the council if they felt this item should be deferred but it was agreed that it should be discussed at tonight's meeting.

A number of objections were raised to the planning application. These included:

- Over-development of the site
- Height and scale of the building
- The impact on the street scene in a conservation area
- The loss of trees, green space and wildlife habitat
- Flooding
- Insufficient parking
- Damage to Harbury stone walling

The applicant was also present and explained that although the previous application had been approved by SDC, there had been a number of concerns raised by residents. He has therefore submitted a new application in which the position of the house has been altered and moved further away from the neighbouring cottage. A garage has also been added which will require the removal of 2 trees but 2 of the trees which were previously to have been removed will now remain. The planning officer has advised that the proposed changes will result in a better scheme for the street scene and conservation area and will benefit the resident of the neighbouring cottage.

#### Fly-tipping at 1 Dovehouse Lane

A complaint was made that rubbish had been tipped on this site. The complainant was advised that this was outside the remit of the parish council.

#### **SDC Consultation Process**

A complaint has been made to SDC about their consultation process with residents. There is a concern that SDC should do more to publicise consultations to residents.

#### 15/197 Minutes

It was **RESOLVED** to approve the minutes of the ordinary parish council meeting held on Thursday, 22 October 2015 as a true and complete record of that meeting.

#### 15/198 Councillor Vacancy

There were 2 candidates for the vacancy. It was **RESOLVED** (proposed Cllr Mancell, seconded Cllr Lockley) to vote by means of a secret ballot. The votes were then counted by the clerk and Mrs Linda Ridgley. It was **RESOLVED** to co-opt Chris Christou to the vacancy as he received the majority of the votes.

#### 1 Harbury Library

There is a minor leak in the kitchen roof and the ramp is to be replaced. Could the signage be lowered now that the trees have been removed as this would reveal the front of the building? Cllr Lockley will suggest this to the committee.

Cllr Gibb has attended one meeting so far and is about to have some training. As part of Democracy Week, Cllr Lockley recently attended an assembly to talk about the work of the parish council and this was followed up with a session on ideas for the village. A list was drawn up which has been circulated to councillors. Some of these ideas could possibly be included in the budget for next year.

#### 15/202 Properties

## 1 Play Areas

The properties group had met to discuss the annual inspection report. Some items are to be monitored. A general tidy up and painting of some pieces of equipment is needed and will be included in the budget for next year. The clerk will ask the contractor if he can adjust the gate into the play area as it is closing too quickly at the moment.

#### 2 Playing Fields – Annual Bonfire

The damage to field was discussed. It was agreed to manage the consequences of the bonfire annually by making provision in the budget each year for remediation work.

#### 3 Car Park

The locking plate for the central post is beyond repair. It was agreed to take no action for the moment.

#### 4 Cemetery

#### i Beech Tree at rear of South Parade

The clerk is still waiting to hear from the tree surgeon.

It was noted that a review of the number of available plots should be carried out on completion of the planned soil removal next year. It is possible that the current burial ground will be full within 5 years. It was therefore agreed to draw up a list of local landowners and to write to them to find out if they have a suitable piece of land for a new cemetery.

#### 5 Allotments

There are still some vacant plots and no waiting list.

#### 6 Memorial Bench

A request has been received to install a memorial bench on the verge outside the village hall. It would be of the same design as the one by the bus stop in Vicarage Lane. The bench would be donated to the village. It was agreed that the parish council would pay for the installation.

## 2 Village Improvements

## i Bus Routes Review

A revised route has been proposed by WCC and Stagecoach which would avoid Chapel Street, thereby improving congestion in this road. The proposed route would be closer to Bush Heath Lane and would therefore benefit the new housing development in this area of the village. It was agreed that the PC should consult with local residents and Cllr Gibb and the clerk will work with WCC on this over the next few weeks. The existing bus shelter could possibly be moved to a location near the school in Park Lane and WCC might be able to help with the cost of this. The possibility of new shelters being paid for by advertising had been mentioned to WCC but it was felt that Harbury would not attract enough business. The existing bus stop area outside the supermarket could perhaps be used as a loading bay instead.

#### ii Manor Orchard Green Planting

It had been necessary to remove an old lilac bush recently as it had become overgrown with bramble. A resident has asked if the council would plant something else in its place. Cllr Lockley will consult with residents and report back.

## iii Church Street Road Improvements

The clerk has been trying to arrange a meeting with WCC and is still waiting to hear from them.

Cllr Gibb has ordered a Smartwater marking kit for the bronze plaques which is free of charge from the War Memorials Trust.

The cost of the courts cleaning at £810 plus vat was formally approved.

#### 6 Cradle Swings

It was **RESOLVED** to place an order for new cradle swing seats for Harbury play area. The height of the seats needs to be adjusted and this will be done when the new ones are installed.

#### 7 Grant Request from HEI

Cllr Christou declared a personal interest as he is a member of HEI. The group is asking for £50 towards the cost of setting up a website. It was not clear if HEI meets the grant criteria, i.e. are they a formally constituted group? Cllr Christou will clarify this. Subject to the criteria being satisfied, it was **RESOLVED** to pay a grant of £50.
