# Planning Application at Bush Heath Lane (David Wilson Homes)

Concern was raised about the lack of protection for 3 mature oaks within the development site. There were also concerns about the size of the proposed attenuation pond and drainage. There was a fear that there would be an adverse impact on the drains under Temple End and the culvert at Treens Hill which would result in flooding across the road.

# 16/004 Minutes

It was **RESOLVED** to approve the minutes of the ordinary parish council meeting held on Thursday, 26 November 2015 as a true and complete record of that meeting.

# 16/005 Reports from Other Organisations

# 1 Harbury Library

The area at the front of the building is to be re-landscaped and planted with wild flowers. The hedge will be removed to improve conditions for the new plants. The notice board and cycle rack will be moved in the autumn to the right hand side of the path.

# 2 Harbury School Governors

Cllr Gibb has now attended several meetings. The number of new pupils anticipated in September 2016 is only 17. The governors are looking at ways to increase this.

## 3 Public Safety

- According to an insurance claim survey, Harbury has the lowest burglary rate in the country.
- It was reported that signs have been erected at the Harbury Lane/Fosse Way junction directing JLR traffic away from Chesterton Road.

#### 9 SDC & WCC

#### SDC

- SDC members have been disappointed by WCC's response to the traffic assessment report for GLH and Cllr Saint is following this up.
- The adoption of the draft Core Strategy may be delayed further.
- SDC has reconsidered its previous decision regarding membership of a combined authority and has now decided to join.
- Cllr Harris fully agrees with all the objections local parishes have raised re GLH.

#### WDC

- WCC now has a plan in place for works to resolve the flooding problem at the corner of Temple End and Bush Heath Lane.
- The faulty street light outside the village club in Crown Street is now working again.
- School buses have been running late. The timetable is to be changed.
- The Sec 106 money for Harbury Library will be paid soon. Cllr Stevens is following this up.
- WCC's budget debate may be delayed. The cuts in funding from central government may have to be topped up from reserves.
- The council tax increase will be 3.9%
- The HS2 select committee ends in February.
- WCC is still against joining a combined authority.
- Cllr Stevens will be holding his civic service at All Saints, Harbury on 14 February 2016.

# 1 <u>15/04200/OUT</u>

Outline application (with all matters reserved except for means of access) for up to 1000 dwellings, assembly and leisure floor space and retail floor space and associated public open space and infrastructure. For full description, see link below.

## Land adjacent to the Old Gated Road, Gaydon/Lighthorne Heath

It was **RESOLVED** to object to this application on the following grounds:

- This is a premature application as the supplementary planning document for this site has not yet been approved.
- There will be an adverse impact on the local heritage and natural landscape. The
  application will materially damage the setting of the historic Chesterton Windmill from
  which the new settlement will be both visible and audible.
- There will be a detrimental impact on traffic and local infrastructure. There is already severe traffic congestion on local roads with the Fosse Way in particular being very dangerous at peak times.
- There is a lack of provision of public transport.
- There is no secondary school on site.

# 2 15/00976/OUT

Outline application (with all matters reserved except for principal means of access to the highway) for construction of a residential development (up to 2,000 houses) and associated infrastructure (for full description see link)

# Land at Gaydon/Lighthorne Heath

It was **RESOLVED** to object to this application on the same grounds as listed above for the other application for this site ref 15/04200/OUT.

#### 3 15/03618/OUT

Outline planning application for zero carbon sustainable community of up to 800 dwellings including live/work units, employment land, shops businesses, primary school, open space and associated infrastructure. For full description see link below.

# Lower Farm, Southam Road, Stoneythorpe

It was **RESOLVED** to object on the following grounds:

- The site is not part of the draft core strategy.
- It will have an adverse impact on traffic and local infrastructure. Local roads are already heavily congested at peak times.
- It is too close to the Biffa landfill and recycling site.
- There will be a further loss of open countryside.
- There are no medical services proposed for the site which will lead to increased pressure on existing services.
- There has been no consultation in surrounding villages.

Erection of up to 80 dwellings with associated public open space and play facilities, access, drainage, infrastructure and parking.

## Former Harbury Cement Works, Station Road, Bishop's Itchington

It was **RESOLVED** to make no representation.

The developer was present and gave an update on the site. The main site builder will be David Wilson Homes. The St Francis Group will be carrying out remediation work before it is

handed over to the builder. The tree work which has recently been approved by SDC under the TPO, will take place before the bird nesting season begins. There will also be some detailed site investigation work taking place which will involve drilling and the use of various pieces of equipment. They are continuing to work with WWT who will take over the management of the nature reserve. The planning application for the doctors' surgery has now been submitted to SDC.

# 7 15/04316/REM

Erection of 75 dwellings together with associated internal roads, parking, landscaping, open space, play areas and all details required by Condition 1 relating to reserved matters of layout, scale, appearance and landscaping.

#### Land west of Bush Heath Lane

It was **RESOLVED** to make no representation but it was noted that the parish council needs to be consulted on the street lighting in due course.

A representative of David Wilson Homes was present. He had noted the comments about the protection of the oak trees and referred to the tree survey previously carried out on behalf of Gladman. They would like to meet regularly with the parish council over the coming months. They hope to start work on site in the summer with the first occupation taking place in March 2017.

## 8 Neighbourhood Development Plan

Further amendments have been requested by the steering group so approval of the plan has been delayed until next month. Any unspent grant is due to be re-paid. Cllr Summers will obtain a quote for the printing of the plan.

The football club had provided details of their income and expenditure and had asked the council to review the fee for hiring the pitch. It was **RESOLVED** to waive the fee for 2015/16 and invite them to a meeting with the properties group to discuss the terms of agreement.

## 3 Car Park

A request has been received to use the car park for a charity car boot sale. It was agreed that this could take place subject to the car park being left in a clean and tidy condition and there being no football match on that day. It was agreed that no hire fee would be charged as the event is for charity.

It was noted that some sections of the concrete drainage channel had come loose. The clerk will arrange for this to be repaired.

## 4 Cemetery

Now that a lot of the undergrowth has been cleared, it has left the boundary with 4 South Parade exposed. A fence has now been installed and some whips planted.

# 1 Street Lighting

#### i <u>Lantern Replacement</u>

The quotes had been circulated prior to the meeting. It was **RESOLVED** to place an order with WCC for replacement of 11 Windsor lanterns with LEDs.

# ii Renewal of Maintenance Contract

It was **RESOLVED** to renew the maintenance contract for 2016/17 including the LEDs.

# iii Deppers Bridge – Lighting of Chicanes

Costs for various options, including solar powered bollards, had been obtained but it was agreed that it was still too expensive to install any additional lighting. The cheapest option was £7,500.

- The rotten 40mph sign at the junction of Vicarage Lane and Bush Heath Road has been replaced.
- The light at Deppers Bridge phone box is not working. No action is to be taken.

## 1 Budget 2016/17

It was **RESOLVED** (proposed Cllr Lockley, seconded Cllr Gibb) to approve the draft budget for 2016/17 (circulated to members prior to the meeting) without amendment.

# 2 Precept 2016/17

It was **RESOLVED** (proposed Cllr Lockley, seconded Cllr Gibb) to set the precept for 2016/17 at £97,664.

# 3 External Audit from 2017

It was **RESOLVED** <u>not</u> to opt out of the arrangements put in place by the Smaller Authorities Audit Appointments Ltd (SAAA) which will take effect from 1 April 2017.

# 4 Harbury Post Office – Grant Application

It was **RESOLVED** (proposed Cllr Gibb, seconded Cllr Christou) to award a grant of £1700 to Harbury Post Office towards the installation of a disabled ramp access. The council felt that every effort should be made to support the post office which is an essential service in the village.

# 5 Harbury Village Cinema – Grant Application

No details had yet been received. This item was deferred for discussion at the next PC meeting.

## 6 Monthly Financial Report

The clerk pointed out the unexpected invoice from WCC in respect of the replacement street lighting column in Constance Drive which had been knocked down by Biffa last summer. She has now invoiced Biffa for the replacement. There were no other questions.
